

# STUART'S RIDE

Confederate General J.E.B. Stuart was one of the most colorful characters of the American Civil War. Join RICHMOND DISCOVERIES as we retrace the route of his famous ride around the army of Union General G.B. McClellan on the new **STUART'S RIDE, Virginia Civil War Trail**. It was this event in June of



1862 that brought Stuart fame. The tour begins just north of Richmond, where Stuart's column passed through Richmond's outer defense lines and processes on a hundred mile arc around Richmond through the rolling hills, across creeks and rivers into the broad open plains of Tidewater Virginia. Pass key sites, including Hanover Court House, Old Church, Linny's Corner, Tunstall's Station, Talleyville, Forge Bridge, and more. Tour the newly renovated Hickory Hill Plantation, home of one of Stuart's brigade commanders. Visit the hauntingly beautiful Summer Hill Plantation

family graveyard (weather and availability permitting), where the only man killed on Stuart's ride, the dashing Capt. William Latané, lies buried. One of our famous "Richmond Alive!" historical characters will meet us along the route and transport your group back in time as they tell the true story of trials and tribulations faced by Virginia civilians during the war. A fine Virginia boxed lunch is included on this tour.

**Optional:** The New Kent Winery is along the route of Stuart's Ride at Talleyville, the site of one of Stuart's stops. A tour and tasting can be added for an additional fee.
