3 DAYS, 2 NIGHTS

DAY ONE

Arrive mid-afternoon into Richmond for an Introduction to Richmond city driving tour that will include a stop at the [Virginia State Capitol](#). Afterwards, check-in and settle into your hotel. For dinner tonight, choose one of the two options below:

DAY TWO

Just east of Richmond on America's oldest highway you will visit one of the great [James River Plantations](#). Return to Richmond for a tour of [St. John's Church](#), site of Patrick Henry's "Liberty or Death" speech. Lunch is on your own in historic Shockoe Slip. After lunch enjoy a guided tour of [Agecroft Hall](#), an English manor house moved to Richmond in the 1920's. Explore the [White House of the Confederacy](#), home to the Jefferson Davis family during the War Between the States.

DAY THREE

This morning, we begin with a drive down Monument Avenue, Richmond's most beautiful boulevard. Explore [Hollywood Cemetery](#), one of America's great Victorian cemeteries and the final resting place of two U.S. Presidents. Visit the [Lewis Ginter Botanical Garden](#) and enjoy lunch on your own in their café before returning home.
